DUTIES

1. To assist the delivery of physical activity sessions to inactive children in disadvantaged areas of Leeds using inclusive coaching approaches.
2. To assist in delivering breakfast, lunchtime, after school and community sessions to engage children of all abilities.
3. To attend events and galas as appropriate for the Ace project.
4. To ensure a professional relationship is maintained with partners, schools and community.
5. To assist in the administrative records relating to coaching sessions, including registers maintaining data protection principles at all times.

7. Work with due regard to ensure Health & Safety is followed at all times.
8. To respond to accidents with the appropriate measures of first aid, ensuring that all records relating to accidents are completed immediately afterwards.
